## **ACROSS**

- **1.** BASEL ("somewhere in Switzerland") is EL ("the Spanish," or "the" in Spanish) "pursuing," or following, BAS ("degrees," i.e., bachelors of arts)
- **4.** SPOOK ("spy") is SK ("Stanley Kubrick, initially," or Stanley Kubrick's initials) "capturing" POO ("#2").
- **5.** STERN is both a synonym for "forbidding" and a "part of a ship."

## **DOWN**

- **1.** BUSES ("some public transportation") is B ("bishop," i.e., the chess abbreviation for "bishop") plus USES ("utilizes").
- **2.** STOLE means both "pilfered" and a type of "scarf."
- 3. LIKEN ("compare") is a homophone ("for an audience") of LICHEN ("tree growth").
