- 5. ERECT ("standing") is made from ERE ("before") and CT ("Connecticut").

DOWN

- **1.** BASIE is the "jazz legend" you get when the letter I ("ego") "infiltrates" the word BASE ("foundation").
- 2. SAUCE ("dressing") is an anagram ("haphazard") of CAUSE.
- **3.** ASSET ("talent, perhaps") is the name BASSETT ("Actress Angela") with its first and last letters removed ("limitless").
